This time, under the theme "Design for Humanity: Preservation and Utilization of Water,"

we aim to envision projects that contribute to solving "global" issues related to

preservation and utilization of water starting from the point of view of "local."

Participating graduate students from doctoral and master's programs in mixed group,

through discussions, activities, modeling, and poster presentation, can acquire the

ability of leadership, interdisciplinary knowledge, and communication, to not only lead a

team as a researcher or an entrepreneur but also create a collaboration, establish

networks with researchers in other specialties, understand the extraprofessional

knowledge and a new viewpoint by cultural exchange.

On the final day, each team will participate in poster presentation. Teams with excellent

project proposals will be awarded.
